

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

### INDICATION FOR USE:

The Merit Advance Angiographic Needle is indicated for providing a puncture site in blood vessels for the introduction of vascular access devices.

#### **PRECAUTIONS:**

- Read manufacturer's instructions prior to use.
- Contents of unopened, undamaged package are sterile.
- Do not use if package is damaged.
- R ONLY CAUTION: Federal (U.S.A.) law restricts the sale of this device to sale by or on the order of a physician trained in the use of this device.
- For single patient use only. Do not reuse, reprocess or resterilize. Reuse, reprocessing or resterilization may compromise the structural integrity of the device and/or lead to device failure which, in turn, may result in patient injury, illness or death. Reuse, reprocessing or resterilization may also create a risk of contamination of the device and/or cause patient infection or cross-infection or cross-infection, including, but not limited to, the transmission of infectious disease(s) from one patient to another. Contamination of the device may lead to injury, illness or death of the patient.

### CONTRAINDICATIONS:

There are no contraindications associated with the Merit Advance Angiographic Needle.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:**

- 1. Identify the insertion site and prepare the site using proper aseptic technique and local anesthesia as required.
- 2. Remove the Merit Advance Angiographic Needle from package using proper aseptic technique.
- 3. Insert a Merit Advance Angiographic Needle using standard technique.
- 4. Dispose of the Merit Advance Angiographic Needle in an approved sharps container while observing universal precautions.
